PURPOSE BUILT *DESIGN*

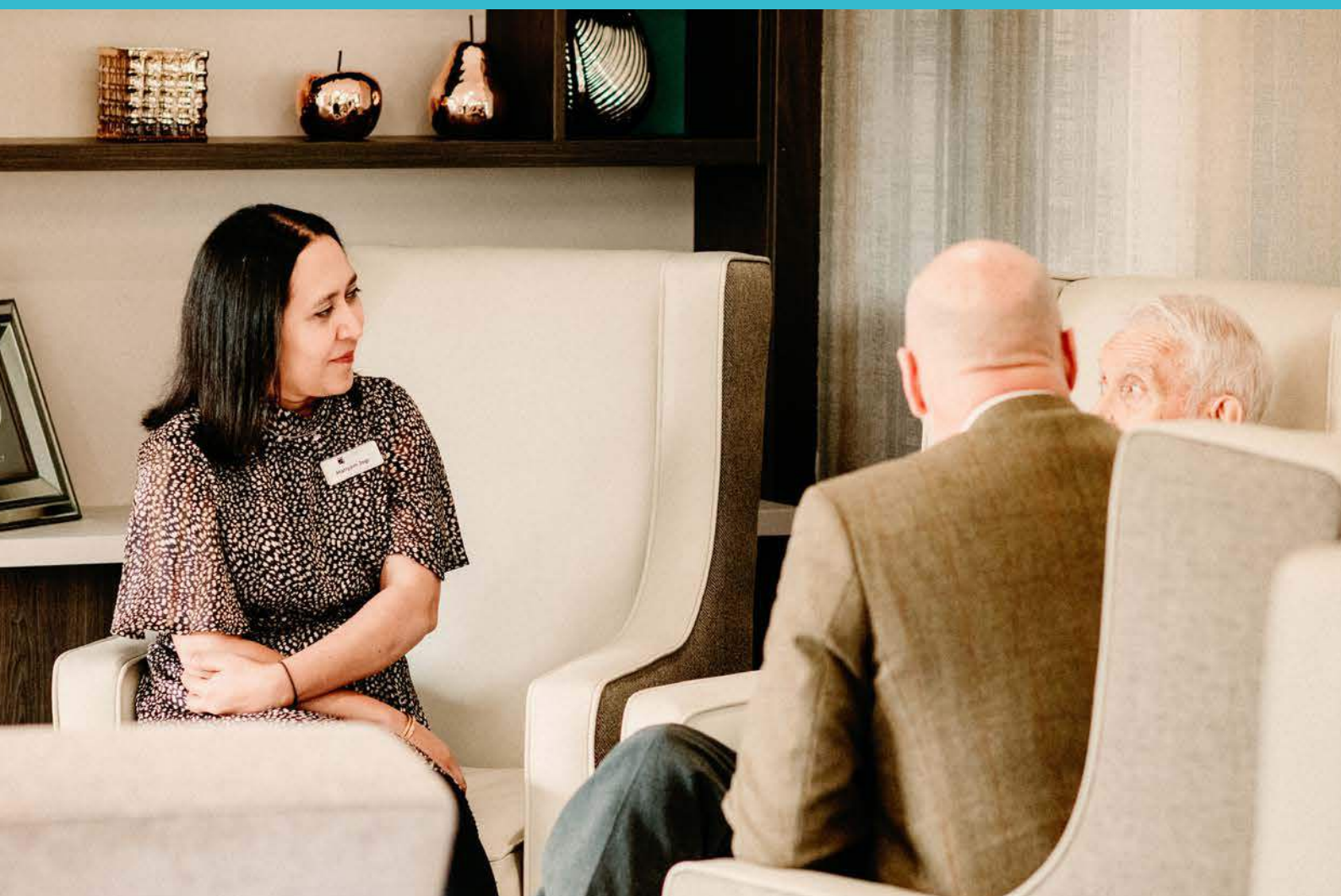
Our fees are fully inclusive of the following:

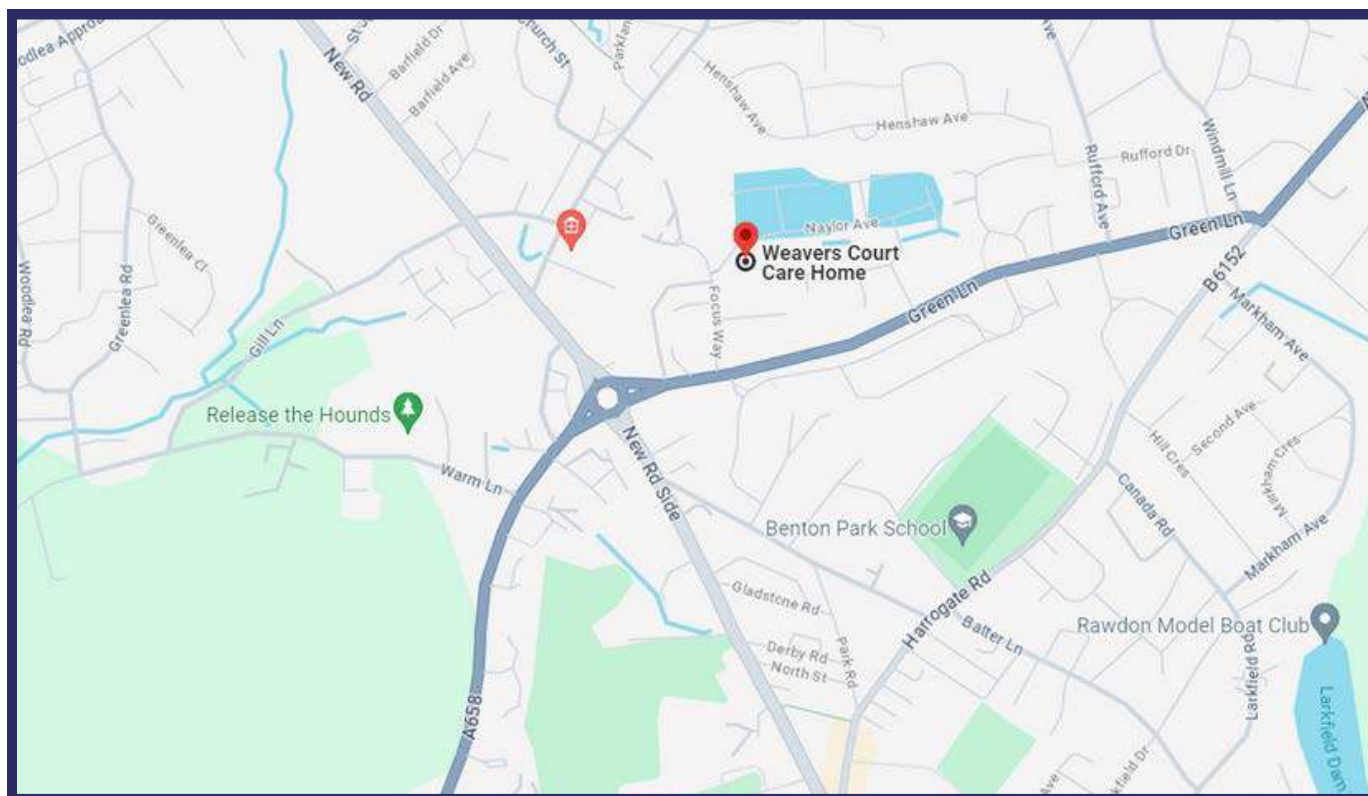
